
As we pause at the midpoint of the term, Milestone College celebrates the steady momentum built through shared effort, resilience, and purpose.


As the exams continue, we encourage parents to keep their children in prayer. A calm, positive mindset can make all the difference during this crucial time.

From 'Boondoggle to 'Disembogue', they spelled their way to victory!






