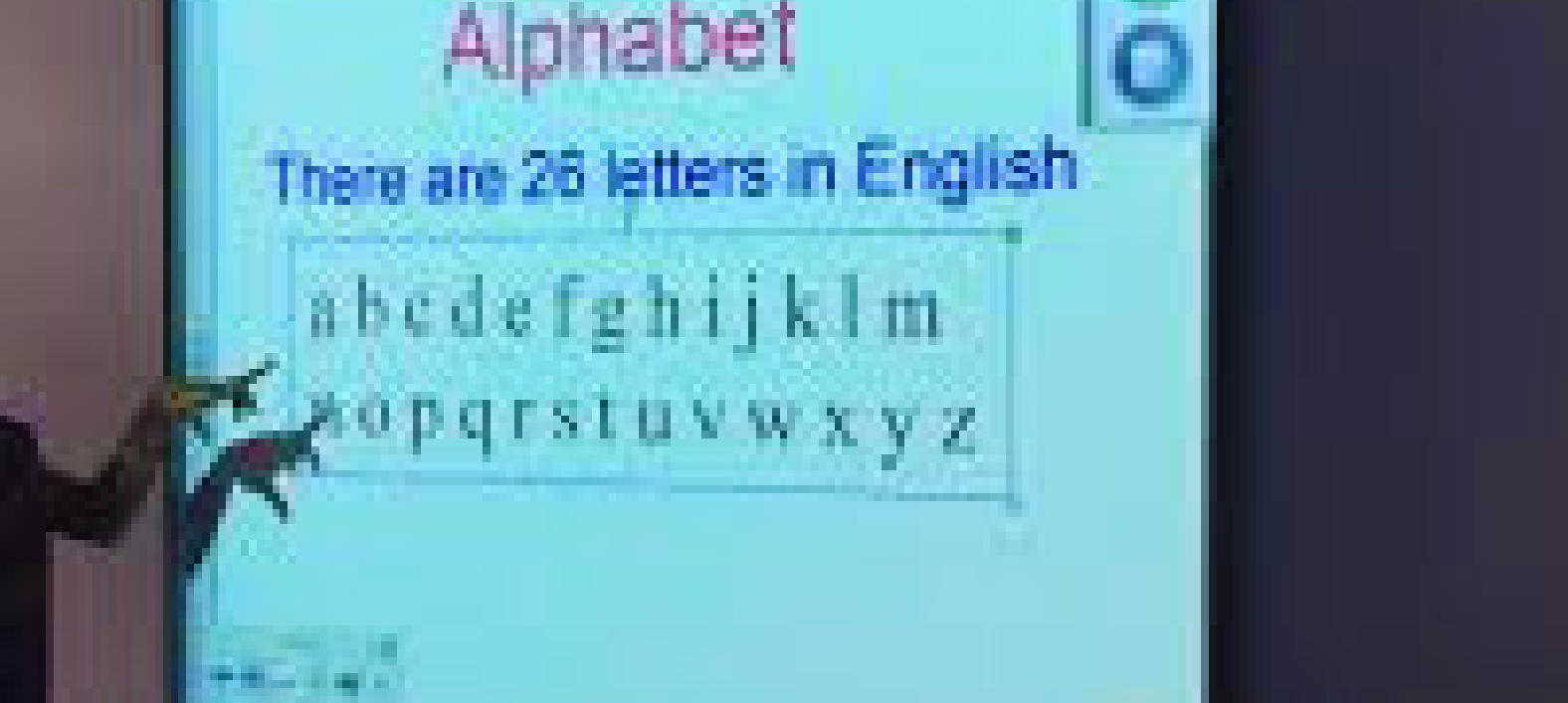
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

The exercise of registering our learners progressed very well. All our learners were successfully registered. Thank you our parents and guardians for paying the examination fees timeously.

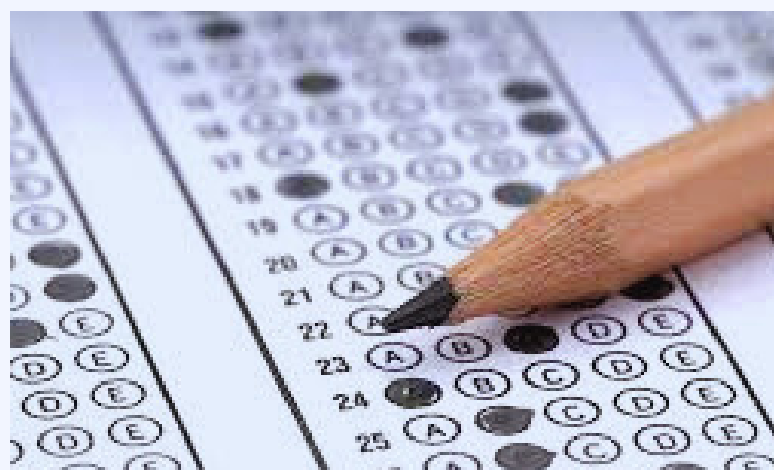

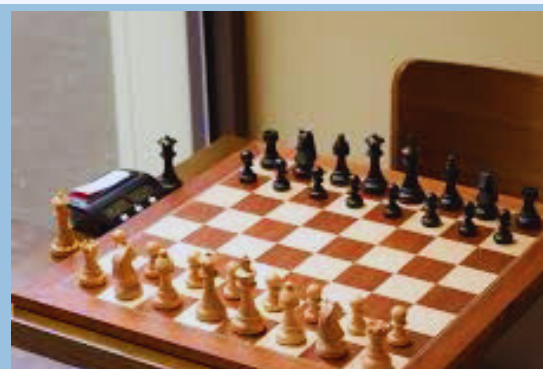
